Day 1

Fly to France

- DAY 1: HOME - PARIS
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night to France.

Day 2

Arrival - Paris City Tour and Meet Host Family

- Ile de la Cite: Explore Ile de la Cite - see the Sainte-Chapelle and the Conciergerie.
- Pastry Tour: Visit the best pastry and chocolate boutiques in the Marais neighborhood - a sweet introduction to the hidden gems of the Marais.
- Marais: Explore the Marais at your own pace. Do not miss Place des Vosges, one of the most beautiful squares in Paris.
- Return: Return to your host family for dinner followed by overnight accommodation.

Day 4**Opera Garnier, Cinema Walking Tour and French Movie Screening**

- Breakfast: Breakfast with your host families. Board the train to Paris with your group.
- Opera Garnier: Discover Opera Garnier - known to be the inspiration for "The Phantom of the Opera".
- Cinema Tour: Follow a local guide on a movie-themed walking tour to discover the mythical figures of the early stage of cinema in France.
- Cinema Screening: Experience France's Cinema at an authentic French Movie Theater. Learn about the history of the venue before immersing yourself in French culture during a private screening of one of France's Classics!
- Return: Return to your host family for dinner followed by overnight accommodation.

Day 5**Street Art Paris, Open Market, Seine Cruise and Eiffel Tower**

- Breakfast: Breakfast with your host families. Board the train to Paris with your group.
- Street Art: Join Street Art Paris and discover large-scale murals by French and international artists of the 13th Arrondissement.
- Market: Spend some time at a Paris open-air street market - interact with the vendors and experience daily life as a local.
- Seine Cruise: Admire the architecture of Paris from the Seine aboard a Bateau Mouche.
- Eiffel Tower: Get a bird's eye view of Paris from the observation platforms of the Eiffel Tower.
- Return: Return to your host family for dinner followed by overnight accommodation.

Day 6**Farewell to Host Family - High-Speed Train to Bordeaux**

- Breakfast: Have breakfast and then say "Au Revoir" to your host families.
- Train: Transfer by bus to the train station. Take the High-Speed Train to Bordeaux.
- Bordeaux Tour: Guided walking tour of Bordeaux - its historic center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stroll on Bordeaux's famous Miroir d'Eau, see the Grand Theater, the Cathedral, and Tower Pey-Berland.
- St-Pierre Quarter: Explore the lively St-Pierre Quarter at your own pace.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Bordeaux.

Day 7**Saint-Emilion UNESCO Village and Le Bournat**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
