## Day 1

### Fly to France

- DAY 1: HOME - PARIS
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night to France.

## Day 2

### Arrival - Champs Elysees and Seine Cruise

- Welcome: Bienvenue en France! Meet your Prometour Tour Director upon arrival. Transfer to your hotel and drop off your luggage.
- Champs Elysees: Explore Paris with your Prometour Tour Director - see Place de la Concorde, the Champs Elysees, the Arc de Triomphe, and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

## Day 3

### Pantheon, Shakespeare Bookstore, Victor Hugo House and Pere Lachaise

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Cafes: Pass by Cafe de Flore and Cafe des Deux Magots in the Saint-Germain-des-Pres neighborhood - where French intellectuals such as Jean-Paul Sartre and Simone de Beauvoir spent their time.
- Pantheon: Enter the Pantheon - the resting place of many great French figures such as Victor Hugo and Emile Zola.
- Shakespeare: Enter Shakespeare and Company Bookstore in the heart of Paris.
- Victor Hugo: Visit La Maison de Victor Hugo, where he wrote some of his major works facing Place des Vosges.
- Pere Lachaise: Discover the Pere Lachaise Cemetery - the final resting place of Balzac, Marcel Proust, Oscar Wilde, Edith Piaf, and more.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

**Day 4****Versailles Gardens and Montmartre**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Versailles: Board the RER train towards Versailles. Guided visit of the Chateau de Versailles - see the Grand Apartments, the Royal Chapel, and the Hall of Mirrors.
- Gardens: Explore the elegantly landscaped Gardens of the Chateau.
- Montmartre: Discover Quartier Montmartre, known as "La Butte" - enjoy the always lively Place du Tertre.
- Dinner: Dinner in a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

**Day 5****Maison de Balzac and Quartier Montparnasse**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Balzac House: Tour the House of Honore de Balzac - let the guide tell you all about the writer of La Comedie Humaine.
- Montparnasse: Discover the Quartier Montparnasse - the heart of intellectual and artistic life during the Roaring 20s. Writers such as Hemingway and Fitzgerald frequented cafes like La Closerie des Lilas and La Rotonde.
- Quartier Latin: Explore Paris at your own pace or shop at the Le Petit Prince Store in the Quartier Latin - dedicated to Saint-Exupery's masterpiece!
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

**Day 6****Rouen and the Le Havre Literary Walk**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Rouen: Travel to Normandy. Discover Rouen - home to French novelists including Corneille and Gustave Flaubert, who made his hometown famous in Madame Bovary. Explore Rouen and take a look at the Gros Horloge.
- Le Havre: Travel to Le Havre. Discover the coastal town through quotes of famous French authors from 1830 to 2014. The Literary Walk is divided into 20 stops indicated by benches.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Le Havre.

**Day 7****Etretat Chalk Cliffs and Return to Paris**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Etretat: Continue to Etretat. Admire the Etretat Chalk Cliffs - a natural beauty with dramatic views of the English Channel and home to the author of Arsene Lupin. Explore the village at your own pace.
- Return: Return to Paris. Head to Place du Trocadero and have a stroll through the Champs de Mars.
- Eiffel Tower: Get a bird's eye view of Paris from the observation platforms of the Eiffel Tower.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

- Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport. Say Au Revoir to your Prometour Tour Director.
