Day 1

Fly to France

- DAY 1: HOME - PARIS
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night to France.

Day 2

Arrival - Arc de Triomphe and Seine Cruise

- Welcome: Bienvenue en France! Meet your French Prometour Director upon arrival.
- City Tour: Walk by Place de la Concorde, stroll along the Champs Elysees - considered the most beautiful avenue in the world. Reach the Arc de Triomphe, wherein lies the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
- Seine Cruise: Admire the architecture of Paris from the Seine aboard a Bateau Mouche.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 3

Musee d'Orsay, Quartier Latin and Ile de la Cite

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Musee d'Orsay: At Musee d'Orsay, originally a railway station, explore the collection of French art from the 19th and 20th century.
- Quartier Latin: Walk through the Quartier Latin - see the Luxembourg Gardens, the Pantheon, and the Sorbonne University.
- Berthillon: Stop at Maison Berthillon to taste their famous gourmet ice cream.
- Ile de la Cite: Discover Ile de la Cite - see the Conciergerie and the Sainte-Chapelle.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 4**Vimy Ridge WWI Memorial and Newfoundland Memorial**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Vimy Ridge: Travel to Vimy. Guided visit of the WWI Memorial at Vimy Ridge - walk through the reconstructed trenches of the battlefield.
- Newfoundland Memorial: Stop at the Newfoundland Memorial in Beaumont-Hamel - a lasting tribute to all Newfoundlanders who served during WWI.
- Travel: Travel to Amiens.
- Dinner: Have dinner with your group in a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Amiens.

Day 5**Etretat Chalk Cliffs and Honfleur Maritime Museum**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Etretat: Board your bus and travel to Etretat. Admire the Etretat White Chalk Cliffs - the last location of the 1927 "White Bird" biplane, which attempted the first non-stop transatlantic flight.
- Honfleur: Continue to Honfleur. Walk along the picturesque Vieux Bassin. Visit the Maritime Museum - learn about the fascinating story of explorers such as Samuel de Champlain, who left for Canada from Honfleur.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Caen.

Day 6**D-Day Beaches, Juno Beach Centre and Canadian Cemetery**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- D-Day Museum: Enter the D-Day Landing Museum - the first museum built in commemoration of June 6th, 1944 and the Normandy Campaign.
- D-Day Beaches: Step on the D-Day Beaches - the landing site for the invasion and liberation of Europe during World War II.
- Juno Beach: Visit the Juno Beach Center - dedicated to the 45,000 Canadians who lost their lives during WWII.
- Canadian Cemetery: Stop by the Canadian War Cemetery - lay a wreath of flowers to honor the soldiers of the WWII Battle of Normandy.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Caen.

Day 7**Memorial de Caen and Mont Saint-Michel**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Memorial de Caen: Visit the Memorial de Caen - it commemorates the Second World War and the Battle for Caen.
- Explore Caen: Explore Caen at your own pace - the city is known for its historical buildings built during the reign of William the Conqueror.
- Mont Saint-Michel: Explore the 16th-century Abbey of Mont Saint-Michel - a UNESCO Heritage site since 1979.
- Dinner: Dinner with your group.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Saint-Malo.

Day 8**Saint-Malo - Jacques Cartier's Port and Return to Paris**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Saint-Malo: Follow a local guide on a walking tour of Saint-Malo - see the Fort National, Saint-Vincent Cathedral, and walk on the beach where Jacques Cartier sailed from when he discovered Canada!
- Return: Board your bus and return to Paris.
- Eiffel Tower: Get a bird's eye view of Paris from the observation platforms of the Eiffel Tower.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 9**Fly Back Home**

- DAY 9: PARIS - HOME
- Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport. Say Au Revoir to your Prometour Tour Director. Board your flight and return home.
