## Day 1

### Fly to Germany

- DAY 1: HOME - GERMANY
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night to Germany.

## Day 2

### Arrival - Berlin Topography of Terror

- Welcome: Welcome to Germany! Meet your Prométour Tour Director upon arrival. Transfer by bus to your hotel to drop off your luggage.
- Topography of Terror: Visit the Topography of Terror - during the Third Reich the headquarters of the Secret State Police, the SS, and the Reich Security Main Office were located at this site.
- Dinner: Dinner with your group in a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Berlin.

## Day 3

### Berlin Wall, Holocaust Memorial and GDR Museum

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Berlin Tour: Join your local guide for a tour of Berlin's main sites - Brandenburg Gate, the Reichstag Building, Potsdam Square, the Holocaust Memorial, the East Side Gallery, and the Berlin Wall.
- GDR Museum: Enter the Museum at the Kulturbrauerei - a contemporary German history museum focused on everyday life in the German Democratic Republic.
- Dinner: Dinner with your group in a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Berlin.

**Day 4****Potsdam - Wannsee Conference, Bridge of Spies and Cecilienhof**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Potsdam.
- Wannsee: Enter the House of the Wannsee Conference - in 1942, leading figures in the Nazi government met here to plan the Final Solution.
- Bridge of Spies: Cross Glienicke Bridge - used for the exchange of captured spies and known as the Bridge of Spies.
- Cecilienhof: Guided visit of Cecilienhof Castle - where the Allied leaders met in 1945 during the Potsdam Conference.
- Return: Return to Berlin.
- Dinner: Dinner with your group in a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Berlin.

**Day 5****Dresden Frauenkirche and Travel to Prague**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Dresden: Board your bus and travel to Dresden. Discover many of Dresden's highlights on a discovery tour with your Tour Director, including the Dresden Frauenkirche - the symbol of the town.
- Prague: Continue to Prague - known for its Old Town Square, the heart of its historic core.
- Dinner: Dinner with your group in a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Prague.

**Day 6****Prague Castle, Charles Bridge and Jewish Quarter**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Prague Tour: Meet your local guide for a visit of Prague - see the Royal Palace, Tyn Church, St-George Basilica, and Golden Lane, once called Alchemists' Alley.
- Prague Castle: See the Castle of Prague - a collection of structures dating from the 10th to the 20th century.
- Jewish Quarter: Explore the only central European Jewish Quarter with a local guide - various synagogues, a museum, and the Jewish cemetery. Enter the Old-New Synagogue of Prague.
- Dinner: Dinner with your group at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Prague.

**Day 7****Travel to Krakow**

- Travel: Spend the day traveling from Czech Republic to Poland. Enjoy the scenery and stop en route for lunch on your own.
- Krakow: Upon arrival in Krakow, check-in at your hotel. Explore Krakow at your own pace - spend time in the Main Square.
- Dinner: Dinner with your group at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Krakow.

**Day 8****Krakow - Wawel Hill, Collegium Maius, St. Mary's Church and Jewish Ghetto**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Wawel Hill: Meet your local guide and enjoy a tour of Krakow. Begin with a guided visit of Wawel Hill - visit the Wawel Cathedral and its bells. Stroll along Kanonicza and Grodzka Streets to reach Collegium Maius, the oldest building of the Academia Cracoviensis.
- St. Mary's Church: Continue to the Main Market Square. Visit St. Mary's Church where the stunning medieval altar sculpted by Veit Stoss is located - a bugle call sounds towards the four corners of the world every hour.
- Jewish Ghetto: Explore the Krakow Jewish Ghetto - see Ghetto Heroes Square, once the biggest open space in Krakow Ghetto.
- Dinner: Dinner with your group at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Krakow.

**Day 9****Auschwitz-Birkenau and Polish Cooking Class**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Auschwitz-Birkenau: At Auschwitz-Birkenau partake in a guided visit to the largest Nazi concentration camp where 1.5 million people of 28 different nationalities lost their lives. Today the site is a Museum and UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Return: Return to Krakow.
- Cooking Class: Partake in an authentic Polish Cooking Class with your group!
- Dinner: Dinner with your group at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Krakow.

**Day 10****Fly Back Home**

- DAY 10: KRAKOW - HOME
- Breakfast at the hotel with your group. Transfer to the airport. Say a fond goodbye to your Prometour Tour Director. Board your transatlantic flight and fly back home.
