Day 1

Fly to Greece

- DAY 1: HOME - ATHENS
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night to Greece.

Day 2

Arrival in Athens - Acropolis and Anafiotika District

- Arrival: Kalo?s i?lthate stin Ella?da! Meet your Greek Prométour Tour Director upon arrival. Transfer to your hotel for check-in.
- Lunch: On your own.
- Anafiotika District: Join a local guide for a walk through the Anafiotika District, considered to be the last corner of 19th-century Athens.
- Acropolis: Visit the Acropolis, Parthenon, Erechtheum, and the Acropolis Museum.
- Plaka: Enjoy some free time in the Plaka to discover this old and historical neighborhood of Athens.
- Dinner: At an authentic local restaurant.
- Overnight: Athens.

Day 3

Athens to Kalambaka - Meteora

- Breakfast: At the hotel with your group.
- Kalambaka: Board your bus and travel to Kalambaka, the gateway to Meteora. The town is almost entirely modern, having been burned to the ground during WWII.
- Lunch: On your own.
- Meteora: Visit the UNESCO World Heritage site of Meteora - be amazed at those monasteries built on natural sandstone rock pillars! The name Meteora means "Suspended in the air."
- Dinner: At an authentic local restaurant.
- Overnight: Kalambaka.

Day 4**Kalambaka to Delphi**

- Breakfast: At the hotel.
- Delphi: Board your bus and travel to Delphi, once considered to be the center of the world.
- Lunch: On your own.
- Ancient Ruins: Discover the Ancient Ruins of Delphi with a local guide. Visit the Temple of Apollo, erected on the remains of an earlier temple dating from the 6th century BC.
- Dinner: At an authentic local restaurant.
- Overnight: Delphi.

Day 5**Delphi to Olympia**

- Breakfast: At the hotel.
- Olympia: Head out to Olympia, a sanctuary of Ancient Greece on the Peloponnese peninsula.
- Lunch: On your own.
- Archaeological Site: Visit the Archaeological Site of Olympian Zeus, the Ancient Stadium, and the Archaeological Museum.
- Dinner: At an authentic local restaurant.
- Overnight: Olympia.

Day 6**Olympia to Nafplio**

- Breakfast: At the hotel with your group and Prométour Tour Director.
- Nafplio: Discover Nafplio, a seaport town in Peloponnese, Greece.
- Lunch: On your own.
- Palamidi Fortress: Visit Palamidi Fortress, which dominates the city and the bay. The flag of the new Greece waved for the first time here in 1822.
- Dinner: At an authentic local restaurant.
- Overnight: Nafplio.

Day 7**Nafplio to Athens - Epidaurus Amphitheatre**

- Breakfast: At the hotel.
- Epidaurus: Visit the Epidaurus Amphitheatre, which has wonderful acoustics - in the last row about sixty meters from the stage, spectators can perfectly distinguish the voice of the actors.
- Athens: Board your motor coach and travel to Athens, the center of Greek civilization.
- Lunch: On your own.
- Dinner: At an authentic local restaurant.
- Overnight: Athens.

Day 8**Fly Back Home**

- Breakfast: At the hotel with your group.
- Farewell: Say a fond "Antio" to your Greek Prométour Tour Director.
- Transfer: To the airport.
- Board your transatlantic flight from Athens and fly back home.
