## Day 1

### Fly to Martinique

- DAY 1: FLIGHT TO MARTINIQUE
- Board your flight and fly to Fort-de-France, Martinique.

## Day 2

### Arrival in Fort-de-France

- Arrival: Bienvenue en Martinique! Meet your Martinican Prométour Tour Director upon arrival at the airport.
- Transfer: Transfer to your hotel in Les Trois Ilets for check-in.
- Evening: Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

### Village de la Poterie and Mangrove Tour

- Breakfast: Have breakfast at the hotel.
- Village de la Poterie: Visit the Village de la Poterie, an authentic site of Martinican Heritage. The estate specialized in pottery in the 18th century with the production of bricks, tiles, and other terracotta products.
- Lunch: Enjoy lunch on your own.
- Mangrove Tour: Have a boat tour through the Mangrove with a local guide to learn about the ecosystem and the fascinating wildlife.
- Evening: Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

**Day 4****Jardin de Batala and Musee de la Banane**

- Breakfast: Have breakfast at the hotel.
- Jardin de Batala: Discover the Jardin de Batala - the garden contains about 3,000 varieties of tropical plants from around the world, including 300 types of palm trees.
- Route de la Trace: Travel along the Route de la Trace through the tropical forest to reach the area of Le Morne Rouge.
- Lunch: Enjoy lunch in a local restaurant with your group.
- Musee de la Banane: Visit the Musee de la Banane and learn all about the process of a banana plantation.
- Evening: Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

**Day 5****Local School Visit and Slavery History**

- Breakfast: Have breakfast at the hotel.
- Local School: Learn about the Martinican school system and get to know local students and their teachers by visiting a Local School.
- Lunch: Enjoy lunch on your own.
- Musee de la Canne a Sucre: Visit the Musee de la Canne a Sucre - it retraces over two centuries of history related to the sugarcane economy.
- La Savanne des Esclaves: Discover La Savanne des Esclaves, a re-created old-time slave village. Follow a local guide around the site as you learn about the history of slavery in Martinique.
- Evening: Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

**Day 6****Empress Josephine's Birthplace and Les Salines Beach**

- Breakfast: Have breakfast at the hotel.
- Empress Josephine: Visit the former sugar estate of Marie Joseph Rose Tascher de la Pagerie, who later became Empress Josephine. The museum, a picturesque stone building, is actually her birthplace.
- Habitation Clement: Discover a superb example of 18th-century Creole architecture at Habitation Clement - the estate is located in sugarcane fields and was also a distillery.
- Lunch: Enjoy lunch in a local restaurant with your group.
- Les Salines Beach: Stroll along Les Salines Beach, one of the most beautiful beaches in Martinique. Relax and enjoy!
- Evening: Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

**Day 7****Fort-de-France Discovery and Treasure Hunt**

- Breakfast: Have breakfast at the hotel.
- Fort-de-France: Follow your tour director on a discovery tour of Fort-de-France. See the colorful market, Cathedrale St-Louis, the Schoelcher Library, and admire local artisans' work as you walk through the urban park Place de la Savane.
- Treasure Hunt: Partake in a treasure hunt in Fort-de-France - your knowledge about the island will be tested! Prizes for the winners!
- Lunch: Enjoy lunch on your own.
- Leisure: Have some leisure time for shopping or simply relax at the beach.
- Evening: Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

**Day 8****Catamaran Sailing the Caribbean Sea**

- Breakfast: Have breakfast at the hotel.
- Catamaran: Spend the day on a Catamaran sailing the Caribbean Sea! First you'll see the Fort-de-France Bay and then sail towards the turquoise water of Les Anses Coast.
- Lunch: Have an authentic Creole lunch on board.
- Afternoon: Later in the afternoon, return to Les Trois Ilets.
- Evening: Dinner and overnight at the hotel.
