Day 1 **Fly to France**

- DAY 1: HOME - PARIS
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night to France.

Day 2 **Arrival - Place de la Concorde and Seine Cruise**

- Welcome: Bienvenue en France! Meet your Prometour Tour Director upon arrival. Transfer to your hotel, drop off your luggage.
- City Tour: Explore Paris with your Prometour Tour Director - see Place de la Concorde (formerly Place de la Revolution) and the Champs Elysees.
- Seine Cruise: Admire the architecture of Paris from the Seine aboard a Bateau Mouche.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 3 **Versailles - Grand Apartments, Hall of Mirrors and Trianon Palaces**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Versailles: Board the RER train to Versailles. Guided visit of the Chateau de Versailles - originally built as a hunting lodge for Louis XIII, redesigned as the extravagant Palace under Louis XIV. See the Grand Apartments, the Royal Chapel, and the Hall of Mirrors.
- Gardens: Explore the elegantly landscaped Gardens with a stop at Marie Antoinette's Hamlet and the Trianon Palaces.
- Return: Board the RER train and return to Paris.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 4

Louvre, Conciergerie and Berthillon Ice Cream

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Louvre: Self-guided visit of the Musee du Louvre - this former royal residence is now home to some of the greatest European masterpieces including Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa.
- Tuileries: Spend time in the Jardins des Tuileries.
- Conciergerie: Visit the Conciergerie - it became the first prison of Paris, where Marie Antoinette was detained after the French Revolution.
- Berthillon: Stop at Maison Berthillon to taste their famous gourmet ice cream.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 5

Loire Valley - Chambord, Blois and Tours

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Chambord: Travel the Loire Valley. Discover Chateau de Chambord - started under Francois I and finished under Louis XIV, one of the most recognizable castles in the Loire Valley.
- Blois: Visit the Chateau Royal de Blois - you can find 4 distinct styles of architecture in the castle.
- Tours: Have some time in Tours - it is said that Place Plumereau is the best square in France.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Tours.

Day 6

Chenonceau, Loches Castle and Medieval Life Workshop

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Chenonceau: Discover Chateau Chenonceau - remarkable for its architecture and history, and for the many gardens including a Maze rebuilt from Catherine de Medicis plans.
- Loches: Enter the Royal City of Loches and visit its Castle - the whole town is a historical site with steep streets and magnificent views.
- Medieval Workshop: Participate in the Daily Life in the Middle Ages workshop - through games of comparison, see how today's lifestyle differs from life during medieval times.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Tours.

Day 7**Clos Luce - Leonardo da Vinci Home - and Return to Paris**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Clos Luce: Explore the former residence of Leonardo da Vinci - see some of his marvelous inventions and works at Clos Luce.
- Amboise: Explore the town of Amboise at your own pace.
- Return: Board your bus and return to Paris.
- Eiffel Tower: Get a bird's eye view of Paris from the observation platforms of the Eiffel Tower.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 8**Invalides, Napoleon's Tomb and Pantheon**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Place Vendome: Make your way to Place Vendome - an important square during the French Revolution.
- Invalides: Discover the Invalides - once a hospital, now a complex of buildings containing the Musee de l'Armee and the Dome des Invalides, the resting place of Napoleon.
- Pantheon: Enter the Pantheon - the resting place of many famous people, such as Victor Hugo, Emile Zola, Marie Curie, and Simone Veil.
- Bastille: Explore Place de la Bastille - where the storming of the Bastille took place on the afternoon of July 14th, 1789.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Paris.

Day 9**Fly Back Home**

- DAY 9: PARIS - HOME
- Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer to the airport. Say Au Revoir to your Prometour Tour Director. Board your flight and return home.
