## Day 1

### Fly to Spain

- DAY 1: HOME - MADRID
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night to Spain.

## Day 2

### Arrival - Madrid Art and Reina Sofia

- Retiro and Palacio Real: Enjoy lunch at the famous Parque El Retiro, then head to El Palacio Real for a tour of the royal family's exquisite collection.
- Puerta del Sol: Leisure time at the Puerta del Sol.
- Dinner: Dinner in a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Madrid.

**Day 4****Salamanca University and Avila Medieval Walls**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Salamanca: Guided walking tour of Salamanca - visit the University of Salamanca, founded in 1134, the oldest university in the Hispanic world. See the Old and New Cathedral and Plaza Mayor.
- Avila: Continue to Avila, a medieval city. Walk along the Avila City Wall - dating back to the middle ages, it stretches 1.5 miles around the city with nine gates.
- Avila Cathedral: Enter the Avila Cathedral - considered to be the first Gothic cathedral of Spain.
- Return: Board your bus and return to Madrid.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Madrid.

**Day 5****AVE Train to Barcelona and Gothic Quarter**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Train: Transfer by bus to the train station. Take the AVE High Speed Train to Barcelona.
- Gothic Quarter: Explore Barcelona's Gothic Quarter. See the four columns from the Temple of Augustus which dates back to the first century BC.
- Picasso Museum: Spend some time at the Picasso Museum.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Barcelona.

**Day 6****Gaudi - Casa Batllo, Park Guell and Sagrada Familia**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Gaudi Tour: Meet your local guide and start a journey into the world of Antoni Gaudi. Start at Placa de Catalunya, walk along Passeig de Gracia to admire the facades of Casa Batllo and Casa Mila, continue to Park Guell.
- Sagrada Familia: Enter Gaudi's most famous and persistent work - the unfinished Sagrada Familia.
- Olympic Stadium: Discover the Estadi Olimpic Lluis Companys - renovated in 1989 as the main stadium for the 1992 Summer Olympic Games.
- Magic Fountains: Head to the Magic Fountains of Montjuic to enjoy the show of light, music, and dancing water.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Barcelona.

**Day 7****Figueres - Dali Museum**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Figueres: Board your bus and head out to Figueres. Explore the town of Figueres, birthplace of Salvador Dali. See the Sant Ferran Castle and the Sant Pere Church.
- Dali Museum: Enter the Dali Museum and enjoy the peculiar but highly accessible work of Salvador Dali.
- Return: Board your bus and return to Barcelona.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Barcelona.

**Day 8****Ceramic Workshop and Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Ceramic Workshop: Participate in a ceramic workshop in the heart of the city.
- MNAC: Enter the Museu Nacional d'Art de Catalunya, located within the Palau Nacional - admire the outstanding collection of Romanesque paintings.
- La Rambla: Head for La Rambla for some free time.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Barcelona.
