Day 1

Fly to Spain

- DAY 1: HOME - MADRID
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night to Spain.

Day 2

Arrival - Toledo UNESCO City

- Welcome: Bienvenido a Espana! Meet your Prometour Tour Director upon arrival. Board tour bus and travel directly to Toledo.
- Toledo: With the help of a local guide, learn about Toledo's fortified walls and its legacy of Churches, Squares, Fortress, Mosques, and Synagogues - a UNESCO World Heritage Site for its co-existence of Christian, Muslim, and Jewish cultures.
- Cathedral: Enter the 13th-century Gothic Cathedral Santa Maria - it has numerous elements of Mudéjar architecture. Visit the San Tomé Church.

- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Toledo.

Day 3

Cordoba - the Mezquita

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Cordoba.
- Mezquita: Follow a local guide on a tour of Cordoba. Enter the Mezquita - a medieval Islamic mosque converted into a Catholic Cathedral and regarded as one of the most accomplished monuments of Moorish architecture in Spain.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Cordoba.

Day 4**Sevilla - Cathedral, La Giralda and Alcazar**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Sevilla.
- Sevilla: With a local guide, immerse yourselves in Andalusian culture. See the lovely Plaza de Espana and Maria Luisa Park.
- Cathedral: Enter the Cathedral of Sevilla - the largest Gothic building in the world, containing the remains of Columbus.
- La Giralda: Climb to the top of La Giralda - this Moorish Minaret is the city's most recognizable monument and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Alcazar: Enter the Alcazar - the oldest European royal palace still in use and one of the best remaining examples of Mudejar architecture.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Sevilla.

Day 5**Sevilla - Guadalquivir River and Santa Cruz Quarter**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- River Cruise: Hop on a boat to get a different view of the city from the Guadalquivir River.
- Calle Sierpes: Explore Calle Sierpes - a pedestrian-only street lined with shops and cafes.
- Santa Cruz: Explore the Santa Cruz Quarter, which reflects Sevilla's romantic image. Walk its narrow and tortuous streets.
- Dinner: Dinner in a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Sevilla.

Day 6**Granada - Alhambra and Generalife Gardens**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Granada, in the foothills of the Sierra Nevada mountains.
- Alhambra: Visit the magnificent UNESCO World Heritage Alhambra and Generalife Gardens - explore beyond the beautiful Moorish architecture to learn the history of one of the most visited attractions in the world.
- Albacin: Discover the Albacin Quarter - walk through its narrow twisted streets. See the view from the Mirador de San Cristobal.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Granada.

Day 7**Return to Madrid - Puerta del Sol**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Travel: Board your bus and return to Madrid.
- Puerta del Sol: Have some leisure time at the Puerta del Sol - admire the buildings, people watch, and look for the plaque indicating KM Zero for the roads of Spain.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Madrid.

Day 8**Madrid - Old Quarter, Palacio Real and Parque El Retiro**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Old Quarter: Guided walking tour through Madrid's oldest quarter - see Plaza Mayor, Plaza de Espana, and the Debod Egyptian Temple. Head to El Palacio Real for a tour of the royal collection.
- Parque El Retiro: Explore Parque El Retiro.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Madrid.

Day 9**Fly Back Home**

- DAY 9: MADRID - HOME
- Breakfast at the hotel. Transfer by bus to the airport. Say a fond Hasta Luego to your Prometour Tour Director. Board your transatlantic flight from Madrid and fly back home.
