Day 1

Fly to Dublin

- DAY 1: HOME - DUBLIN
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night.

Day 2

Arrival - Dublin City Tour and Book of Kells

- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Dublin.

Day 3

Croke Park, Belfast and the Murals of the Troubles

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Croke Park: Croke Park has been at the heart of Irish sporting life for over 100 years. Access the GAA Museum of Gaelic Sports and discover the unique story of Gaelic games from ancient times to the present day.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Belfast.
- St. George's Market: Discover St. George's Market - the last surviving Victorian covered market in Belfast with 300 traders, crafters, musicians, and food vendors.
- Murals: With your Tour Director, explore the Great Walls of Belfast and the Murals of the Troubles - learn about the region's past and present political and religious divisions.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Belfast.

Day 4

Giant's Causeway and Derry City Walls

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Giant's Causeway: Explore the Giant's Causeway - an area of nearly 40,000 interlocking basalt columns, the result of an ancient volcanic eruption and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Derry.
- Derry: Join a local guide and learn about the history and culture behind the city of Derry - known for its architecture and a former walled city. Walk the Peace Bridge.
- Guildhall: Discover the Derry Guildhall at your own pace - where elected council members meet and which was the focus of multiple terror attacks during the Troubles.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Derry.

Day 5

Ulster American Folk Park and Galway

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Ulster American Folk Park: With 30 buildings and exhibits, the Ulster American Folk Park is the perfect place to immerse yourself in the story of the brave emigrants who made the journey across the Atlantic to America. Board a full-scale emigrant ship to experience the conditions they faced.
- Galway: Board your bus and travel to Galway. Have time to explore this charming city at your own pace.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Galway.

Day 6

Cliffs of Moher and Craggaunowen

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Cliffs of Moher: Today you will discover the Cliffs of Moher, considered one of the natural wonders of the world. The visitor center will give you a better idea of this spectacular setting. Embark on a voyage of discovery by boat along this 8km shoreline.
- Craggaunowen: Welcome to Craggaunowen, Ireland's Pre-historic Park. Explore the roots of the people, homesteads, animals, and artifacts of Celtic ancestors of over 1,000 years ago.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Killarney.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Killarney.
