Day 1

Fly to London

- DAY 1: HOME - LONDON
- Board your transatlantic flight and fly through the night.

Day 2

Arrival - Roman Londinium and British Library

Day 3

Battle of Hastings and Brighton

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Hastings: Travel to Hastings. Visit Battle Abbey, where in 1066 the armies of King Harold and William the Conqueror clashed. Explore abbey ruins and meet the Normans and Saxons.
- Brighton: Continue your route to Brighton. Explore the seaside town at your own pace - stop by the pier, the i360 Observation Tower, the Jubilee Clock Tower, and the Royal Pavilion.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Brighton.

Day 4**Fishbourne Roman Palace and Bath**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at your hotel with your group.
- Fishbourne: Visit Fishbourne Roman Palace - an important seat in Roman Britain, the largest residential Roman building in Britain, featuring spectacular mosaics.
- Bath: Continue to Bath, a UNESCO World Heritage Site with some of the finest architectural and historical treasures of Europe.
- Roman Baths: Visit the Roman Baths and the Pump Room.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Bath area.

Day 5**Wroxeter Roman City and Chester**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at your hotel.
- Wroxeter: Travel to Wroxeter. At Wroxeter Roman City, discover urban-living 2,000 years ago at Viroconium - once the fourth largest city in Roman Britain. Wander the remains of the bathhouse and explore a reconstructed town house.
- Potteries Museum: Visit the Potteries Museum and Art Gallery - home to the largest hoard of Anglo-Saxon metalwork ever discovered.
- Chester: Continue to Chester.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Chester.

Day 6**Roman Chester with a Centurion and Travel to York**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Roman Chester: Enjoy a guided tour of Roman Chester - with a Roman Centurion in full regalia! Take time to explore Chester at your own pace.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to York.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in York.

Day 7**Jorvik Viking Centre and York**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Jorvik: Visit the Jorvik Viking Centre - built on an important archaeological site, it offers an immersive Viking experience through sights, sounds, and smells.
- Viking Walk: Tour the city of York on a unique Viking Walk - learn how the Vikings had a huge impact on the city itself.
- Yorkshire Museum: Enter the Yorkshire Museum - exploring how York became England's second city and how its fortunes rose and fell with its ties to the Crown and the Church.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in York.

Day 8**Durham Cathedral and Hadrian's Wall**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Durham Cathedral: Enter Durham Cathedral - it boasts a wonderful exhibit of the area's ancient population, with some incredible Viking stonework.
- Hadrian's Wall: Travel to Hadrian's Wall - a defensive fortification in the Roman Province of Britannia begun in AD 122. It is the largest Roman archaeological feature in Britain, running a total of 73 miles.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in York.
