Day 1

Fly to London

- DAY 1: HOME - LONDON

- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in London.

Day 4**Jane Austen's Bath and Stratford-upon-Avon**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Bath: Board your bus and travel to Bath. Visit the Jane Austen Centre - celebrating Bath's most famous resident. The Centre offers a snapshot of what it would be like to live in Regency times.
- Austen Walking Tour: Partake in a walking tour of Jane Austen's Bath - see Pulteney Bridge, Sydney House where Austen lived with her parents for 5 years, and the Georgian splendors of the Royal Crescent and the Circus.
- Stratford: Continue your route to Stratford-upon-Avon.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in the Stratford area.

Day 5**Shakespeare Country and Manchester**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Shakespeare: Discover the Shakespeare houses, Mary Arden's farm, Trinity Church, and the Royal Shakespeare Company with a local guide.
- Birthplace: Visit Shakespeare's Birthplace - the house where he was born in 1564, and wander through the Shakespeare Exhibition.

- Chetham's Library: Visit the oldest public library in the English-speaking world, Chetham's Library.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Manchester.

- Bronte Parsonage: Visit the Bronte Parsonage Museum - the largest and most important in the world, continuing to inspire scholars, writers, and artists.
- Grasmere: Travel to the Lake District. Stop at Sarah Nelson's Grasmere Gingerbread Shop. Enjoy some leisure time in the charming English village of Grasmere - William Wordsworth called it "the loveliest spot that man hath ever found".
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in the Lake District region.

Day 7**Beatrix Potter Museum and Robert Burns Centre**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Beatrix Potter: Visit the Beatrix Potter Museum and learn all about the Peter Rabbit famed author!
- Windermere: Explore the village of Windermere at your own pace, enjoy the lake shore!
- Robert Burns: Travel to Dumfries. Enter the Robert Burns Centre and learn about the famed poet who spent the final years of his life in Dumfries - the exhibition has many of his original manuscripts and belongings.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Dumfries.
