Day 1

Fly to Glasgow

- Canoe Expedition: Start with a half-day canoe expedition with your group! Soak in all the beauty the area has to offer!
- Highland Games: Then let the Highland Games begin! With traditional Highland events like tossing the caber and tug of war, as well as team games and challenges.
- Glasgow: Board your bus and travel to Glasgow.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Glasgow.

Day 4**Ferry to Belfast and City Walking Tour**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel with your group.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Cairnryan.
- Ferry: Board the ferry from Cairnryan and cross the Irish Sea to Belfast.
- Belfast Tour: With your local guide, discover the city's rich history on a walking tour - see the City Hall, which stands as a symbol of Belfast's Industrial Revolution pre-eminence, and discover The Golden Mile.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Belfast.

Day 5**Giant's Causeway and Archery**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Giant's Causeway: Explore the Giant's Causeway - an area of nearly 40,000 interlocking basalt columns, the result of an ancient volcanic eruption and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Archery: Partake in an Archery Course and see if you could give Robin Hood a run for his money!
- Sligo: Continue tour route to Sligo.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Sligo.

Day 6**Connemara National Park and Galway Walking Tour**

- Cliffs of Moher: Today you will discover the Cliffs of Moher, considered one of the natural wonders of the world. The visitor center will give you a better idea of this spectacular setting. Embark upon a voyage of discovery by boat along this 8km shoreline.
- Inis Oirr: Also visit Inis Oirr - the most populous island of the 3 Aran Islands in Galway Bay. Admire the view of the Cliffs from the island.
- Dinner: Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Overnight: Overnight accommodation in Galway.

Day 8**Dublin - Celtic Music and Dance Evening**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Travel: Board your bus and travel to Dublin.
