- **Whitney Plantation:** Visit the Whitney Plantation and gain a unique perspective of the lives of enslaved people through museum exhibits, memorial artwork, restored buildings, and hundreds of personal narratives.
- **Dinner:** Dinner in a local restaurant. On the menu is traditional Cajun Jambalaya!
- **Overnight:** Overnight accommodation in New Orleans.

**Day 3****Creole Cooking Class, Mardi Gras World and Ghost Tour**

- Breakfast: Breakfast at the hotel.
- Cooking Class: Learn about the art of Creole Cuisine with a cooking demonstration followed by lunch.
- Mardi Gras World: Discover the history and traditions of Carnival Mardi Gras with a guided tour of Mardi Gras World. Walk among towering figures of fantasy and see masters of Carnival sculpture and float building in action.
